




USB charger / Audio port

Inserting the SIM card

Please face the chip side of the Nano-SIM card down when inserting it into the slot. Be aware of the direction of the cut edge when placing the Nano-SIM card into the slot.



Memory card installation

Place the metal contact of the memory card down, and be aware of the direction of the cut edge. Then, place the card onto the tray and insert it into the device.

The phone does not come equipped with a memory card, and it should be purchased separately.

Do not plug in and out the SIM card tray when the phone is powered on.

Fingerprint unlocking

You can unlock the screen with the fingerprint ID function.

Click **Settings > Security & Location > Fingerprint**, and scan your fingerprint by following the instructions. Make sure your finger is clean and dry.



Wi-Fi

You can connect your device to a Wi-Fi network, accessing the internet without using your mobile data. From Settings, tap **Network & Internet > Wi-Fi**. When Wi-Fi is on, a list of available connections will be listed. Select your preferred network, enter the password, if required, and tap **Connect.**

Bluetooth ∦

You can connect your device to other
Bluetooth-enabled devices. From **Settings**, tap on **Connected devices > Bluetooth**. Enable the Bluetooth
function by clicking on the Menu button then selecting
"Refresh."

Your phone will search for available Bluetooth devices to pair with, and it will list them on the screen. Next, click on pairing selection and tap "Pair" on the dialog pop-up.

Documents can be transmitted after the Bluetooth pairing process has been completed.

Tip: Slide down the status bar twice to open the shortcut switches for Bluetooth and other functions.


Wi-Fi Hotspot

Wi-Fi hotspot creates a Wi-Fi network from your data plan and will provide a connection forother devices.

Click on Settings > Network & Internet > Hotspot & tethering > Wi-Fi hotspot to turn on the hotspot function.

Camera 🗖


Aim the camera at your point of interest, and your device will focus automatically. You can also tap the screen if you want to focus on a specific part of the screen, then tap the **Capture** O button to take the photo. You can also choose other modes such as video, beautifying, or panorama..




Dual SIM standby

"Dual card, dual standby, single-pass" means you can insert two SIM cards and have them both in "standby", but you will not be able to make phone calls on both at the same time.

Both SIM cards can receive phone calls during standby mode, but when only one SIM card is activated, the second SIM card will not receive and will not make phone calls

How to set up your new Hidr smartphone (regular partition)

- 1. Insert your SIM card and switch on your phone, ensuring it is fully charged
- 2. Select a language
- 3. Connect to Wi-Fi
- 4. Copy apps & data
- 5. Enter your Google account details
- 6. Set up a password and/or fingerprint
- 7. Select your backup and payment options

Step 1

Put your SIM card into your new device. Switch it on using the power button located on the right side.



^{*}Remember that it might need charging before it will switch on.

Step 2

Get Started

Select your preferred language and press Start.

Step 3

Connect to Wi-Fi

Find and select your network in the list, insert your password and click **Connect.**

Step 4

Copy apps & data

To transfer your apps, photos, contacts, Google account, and many more, press **Next** and select the device you want to transfer the data from.

Step 5

Connect to Google account

If you already have a Google account you should enter your email address and password now. If you don't have a Google account, click on **Create a new account** and click **Next**. Click **I Agree** to accept Google's Terms of Service and Privacy Policy.

Step 6

Google Services Setup

The setup process will ask whether you want to turn on or off various Google services, such as the ability to automatically back up device data (recommended), use Google's location service to help apps determine your location, or improve location accuracy by allowing the device to scan for Wi-Fi and Bluetooth even when they're turned off. Toggle these on or off, as preferred, and click on **Accept**.

Step 7

Set screen lock

To keep your Hidr secure, please insert a 4 digits **PIN** code and click on **Next**. Re-enter your **PIN** code for the confirmation and click on **Confirm**.

Step 8

Security (fingerprint & face unlock) Configure your fingerprint to unlock your phone or to approve purchases. **Follow** the on-screen instructions.

*Your fingerprint may be less secure than a strong pattern or 6-8 digits PIN code.

To configure your face unlock open **Settings**, click on **Security** and **Face unlock**, then tap **Continue**.

Step 9

Google Assistant & GPay.

To configure your **Google Assistant** and **Google Pay** please follow the on-screen instructions.

How to set up your new Hidr smartphone (encrypted partition)

Step 1

Open **Settings** and select **Google** (Services and preferences). Open **Set up & restore** and select **Set up your work profile**. Click on **Next** and wait for the download process to be completed.

Step 2

Enroll your Hidr

Select **Allow** and scan the **QR** code available on https://cryptodata.com/hidr. Press **Accept & continue** and wait for the enrolment process to be completed.

Your profile will be registered and CryptoDATA's encrypted apps will be installed on your Hidr.

Step 3

Finishing up

Drop down the control bar and press on the Work profile icon. When the Work profile icon is illuminated your encrypted partition is activated. To only utilize your regular partition switch off your encrypted Work profile.

*When the Work profile is activated, you will receive notifications from apps in both partitions.

*When the Work profile is deactivated, you will not receive notifications from the encrypted apps.
